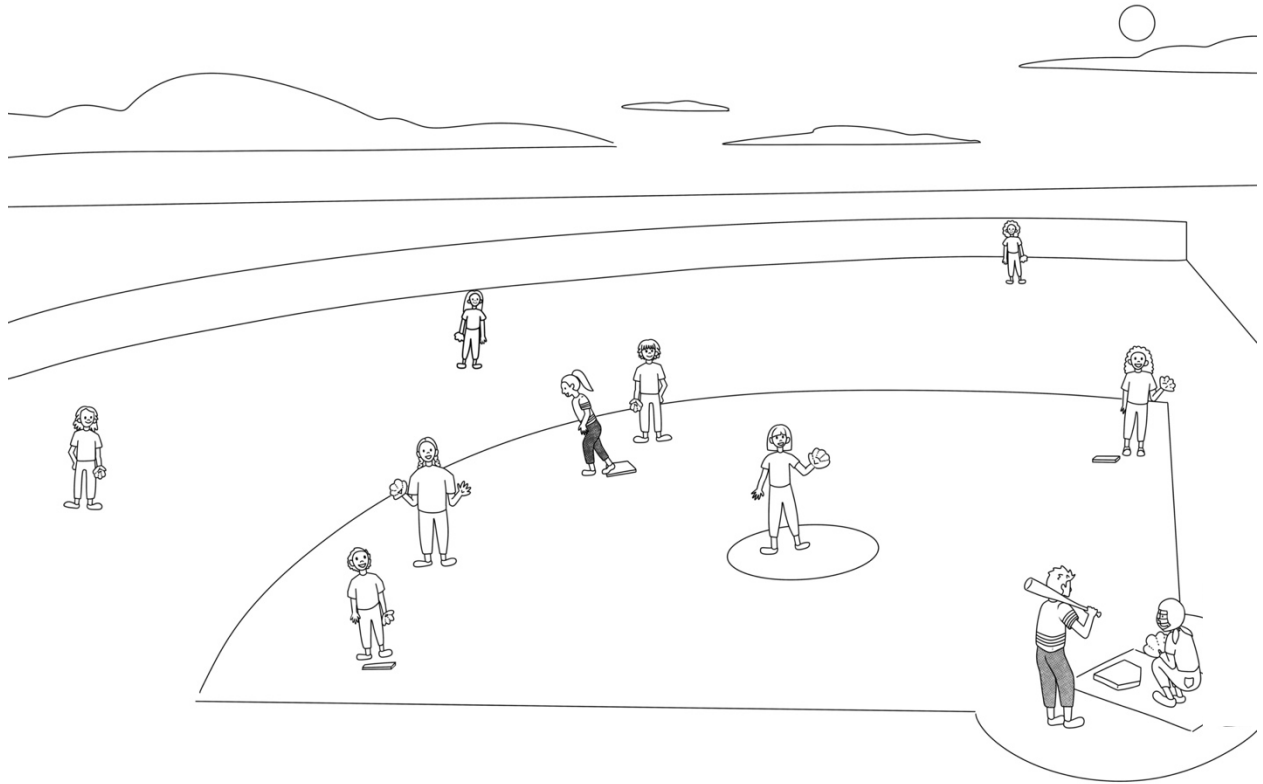


## Math Mondays! April 27, 2025

- When the players are hitting or “sitting out” they sit safely on a bench in a place called a “dugout”

2. Based on the image, how many players are sitting in the dugout currently? Use words and numbers to support your answer.
