## **End of Year Activities**

## 6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

1. Our school has 461 students and 27 teachers. We are playing a rock-paper-scissors war (everyone has beads signifying if they are still in the game, if you lose you must give all your beads to the winner). They need help to get to the car which takes 10 minutes, and the same amount of time will be needed to get them into the gym. My house is 18 miles from my grandparents, we go an average of 42 mph. My grandparents live 25 miles from the school, but we can go an average of 57 mph. What is the latest we can leave my house and make it on time? Justify your answer.
